As directed by the Illinois Community College Board, Selsius™ Corporate and Career Training's function is to assist local businesses, associations, labor, and government to develop a qualified well-trained workforce and to work with state and local economic development personnel in the attraction and retention of business. Selsius™ will serve the District by working with business, industry, and government to provide training, consulting and other services which enhance economic development. Economic development activities are those which create or retain jobs, increase employment opportunities and promote prosperity within the district.

Potential sources of funding include, but are not limited to the Illinois Community College Board Workforce Development Grant, the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity's Employer Training Investment Program (ETIP) and Sector Based Initiative Grants, the US Department of Labor Community Based Job Training Grant, Trade Adjustment Assistance Act, the Workforce Investment Act, fees from contract and customized training for business and industry, and the Education Fund.
