Pursuant with the Illinois Senior Citizen Courses Act, Southwestern Illinois College District 522 residents age 65 and over may be eligible for a tuition waiver for credit courses. Senior citizens tuition waiver requirements are as follows:

- 1. Residents of Community College District 522 age 65 or over.
- 2. Individuals age 65 or older whose annual income is less than the threshold amount provided in Section 4 of the "Senior citizens and Disabled Persons Property Tax Relief and Pharmaceutical Assistance Act" may qualify for a tuition waiver for credit classes.
- 3. Laboratory fees are charged for courses requiring laboratory work; there is no waiver for senior citizens.
- 4. There is no senior citizen tuition waiver for non-credit classes such as Community Service (CSA) classes and Saturday Experience classes.
- 5. The senior citizen tuition waiver is not applicable to any other college fees, textbook costs, or supply costs.
